Fr. Marty's Musings

The Baptism of the Lord ends of the liturgical season of Christmas. We listen to Isaiah proclaim:

I have formed you, and set you as a covenant of the people, a light for the nations, to open the eyes of the blind, to bring out prisoners from confinement.

John the Baptist prepared the way for the Lord, and thirty years after the event that started this season, he baptized Jesus in the Jordan. Jesus' baptism has no sin to wash clean but anticipates Christ's dying and rising.

Water carries both creative and destructive powers. Floods remind us of water's dangerous potential, but we need water for life. When we enter the waters of baptism (powerfully symbolized by immersion) we recall the Passion and death of Jesus. As we rise out of the waters, we enter the new life invited by Christ's resurrection and become one in God's family by divine love.

RENEW MY CHURCH: Divine Providence and the Holy Spirit

Our Grouping Feedback & Discernment Team presented to the Executive Committee of the RENEW MY CHURCH Commission before Christmas. It was a discussion about the local realities of our parishes and communities.



Next Steps

1. The Executive Committee will form a recommendation for the full RENEW MY CHURCH Commission.
2. The Commission will convene and discuss the recommendation, ensuring that the Grouping Team's feedback and the foundational principals for structural viability and vitality have been fully considered.
3. Per Canon Law (Church law), the Commission forwards the recommendation to the Presbyteral Council (an elected body of priests) for their consultation with Cardinal Cupich.
4. The Cardinal will discuss the recommendation with the Presbyteral Council and after this consultation, the Cardinal will make a final decision.
5. We expect to learn of the Cardinal's decision on January 25. We will share as more details emerge.

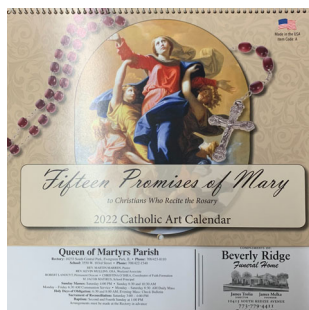

Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. (1 Th 5:16-17)

Pray for St. Bernadette and Most Holy Redeemer (the other parishes in our Evergreen Grouping), Cardinal Cupich, the Presbyteral Council, and the lay faithful who are leading the work of renewal within our archdiocese.

This is only the beginning of the renewal process for our parish. Once the decision has been made, we enter into the next phases of RENEW MY CHURCH: Organizational Transition and Building the New Reality—phases which focus on structural and spiritual renewal within our parish. Remember that no matter what the future holds, our Lord already holds us. We are instruments of his grace, and he will use us to make disciples, build communities, and inspire witness.

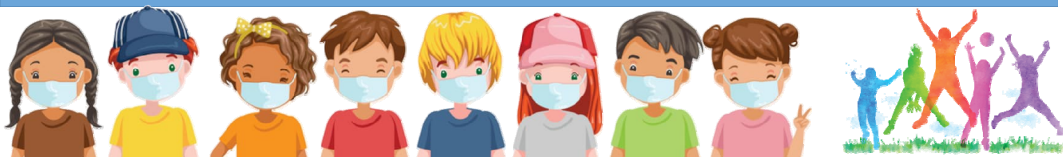

All Things Christmas At Queen of Martyrs School

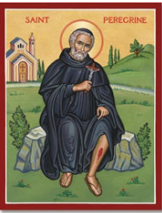

St. Peregrine is the patron saint for persons suffering from illnesses of all types in particular cancer. Saint Peregrine was healed of a cancerous ulcer on his leg which was considered beyond saving. The fame of this event in 1325 spread rapidly round the western Church.

Christians, and especially the sick, began to invoke his name and seek his intercession for the relief of their suffering and even for a cure from sickness. The canonization of St. Peregrine in 1726 increased people's devotion to him which spread to the universal Church.
