# Fr. Marty's Musings

Laetare Sunday echoes the Introit at Mass, "Laetare Jerusalem" ("O be joyful, Jerusalem"—Isaiah 66:10). The Fourth Sunday of Lent reminds us of the hope that fills us with joy each Sunday recalls Easter. This Sunday and Gaudete Sunday in Advent are the only days when rose vestments are worn. Laetare translates as the imperative "rejoice," as the Introit proclaims:

Rejoice, O Jerusalem: and come together all you that love her: rejoice with joy, you that have been in sorrow: that you may exult, and be filled from the breasts of your consolation. Psalm: I rejoiced when they said to me: "we shall go to God's House!"



Rembrandt painted a wonderful illustration of the Prodigal Son parable. Both the parable and painting dramatically represent God's mercy. Christ calls us to be merciful to one another, as the father responds to the prodigal's brother. We pray in the Lord's Prayer, "Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us." Let us be generous with our mercy and reflect the loving compassion of God.

### Pretzels: Food for Lent

Did you know that the pretzels originated as a Lenten food? The image of arms crossed in prayer inspired the traditional pretzel twist. The pretzel originally was eaten only during Lent. It appeared on Ash Wednesday, disappearing on Good Friday. A fifth century manuscript in the Vatican Library illustrates a Lenten pretzel. A special bread was made with flour, salt, and water—abstaining from eggs and milk in Lent.

Monks are credited with twisting dough into the shape to represent arms crossed over the chest (an old posture for prayer) and were called “bracellae” (Latin for “little arms”). In Germany the Latin word became “bretzel,” leading to our “pretzel.” Pretzels were reminders to pray more during Lent, and as rewards for children for learning their prayers. The coarse salt sprinkled on pretzels reminds us that salt is necessary to life. It was so valued that it was used to pay the soldiers of ancient Rome. The word “salary” came from the Latin word for “salt money.” Salt was used for seasoning and preserving food. Pretzels were soft until the mid-19th century, when the Pennsylvania Dutch began making hard pretzels after a baking mistake. The pretzel later became a year-round snack and a favorite of bars and parties (far from its Lenten roots). When you next eat a pretzel, note the image of arms crossed in prayer and offer a prayer of thanksgiving for God’s graces.

### Lenten Regulations

Abstinence from meat is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Ash Wednesday and on all the Fridays of Lent. Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one’s needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. The special Paschal fast, as well as abstinence are prescribed for Good Friday and encouraged for Holy Saturday.

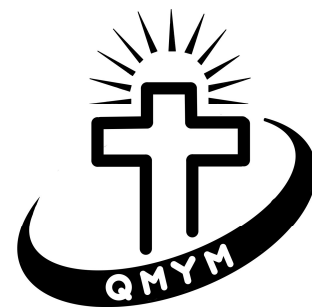

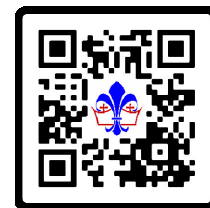

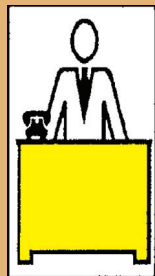
