Fr. Marty's Musings

Pentecost marks the birthday of the Church. The Feast of Pentecost, the fiftieth day after Easter, recalls when the seal of the Holy Spirit transformed Christ's followers into the Body of Christ—the Church. The first Pentecost reversed by public epiphany the chaos of Babel. The Spirit descended on Mary and the disciples and blessed the world with a call to unity. After the tragedies in Uvalde, Buffalo, and Ukraine, this is a healing unity the world very much needs. The disciples shared the Good News with a world divided by language and customs, and the Spirit brought understanding and harmony for that brief shining moment. Let us work for more of these Paraclete-blessed connections with the gifts of the Holy Spirit: Wisdom, Understanding, Right Judgment, Courage, Knowledge, Reverence, Wonder and Awe.

Like the disciples, the inspiration and strength of the Holy Spirit both pulls us together and sends us forth. The flames of the Spirit pushed the disciples, once huddled in an upper room, out into the world to share the gospel message. The Spirit calls us to united mission in Christ.

The Spirit's urging toward harmony can heal divisions. With the assistance of the Spirit that first Pentecost, people understood the message proclaimed by the disciples. The Spirit compels us to share the Good News today. That is the mission that we are sent with at the end of each Mass. We are a Spirit-formed people. May we recognize God's grandeur through the Spirit.



As we recall the Church's beginnings as the Spirit-guided Body of Christ, and seek renewal with our sisters and brothers of St. Bernadette, I encourage you to commit to serve in a liturgical or other ministry. May the Spirit give us the courage and wisdom to witness our faith.
