Fr. Marty's Musings

When I first learned the sign of the cross, my parents taught me to say: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost." I had an aunt, uncle, and cousins (another large family of 10 children) who were parishioners of Holy Ghost in South Holland. Now we use Holy Spirit to describe the third person of the Holy Trinity—the term "Ghost" has become more associated with horror stories, dead entities, or a certain friendly animated figure.

The first Sunday after the Easter season ends honors the Holy Trinity, in whose name we are all baptized. We recall our Baptism when we bless ourselves with Holy Water as we enter a church. The Sign of the Cross offers our prayer to the Trinity: Father, Son, and Spirit. We give praise to our Creator, give thanks to our Savior, and give our hearts to the inspiration of the Paraclete.

Although the translation of the Trinity formula can change (Ghost/Spirit), the wording is important in Baptism. The validity of several Baptisms in recent years have questioned because the minister used the "We baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" instead of the rite's "I baptize you in the name of..." A priest in Detroit was even re-ordained because an invalid formula used at his Baptism brought the validity of his ordination to question.

Because of the connection with the Holy Trinity and Baptism, we use the Sprinkling Rite one additional Sunday as we had throughout Easter. We are renewed and washed in the grace of God as we remember our baptismal promises.

This is an opportunity for the second straight Sunday to open our spirituality to the too-often neglected person of the Trinity: the Holy Spirit. The Paraclete is our

Advocate and the continual reminder of God's divine and saving love for us. As Christ breathed the Spirit into the souls of the disciples, may we breathe deeply and welcome the Spirits seven gifts. As we prepare for a new reality with our sisters and brothers of St. Bernadette, may we be open to different opportunities to reflect the unity of the Trinity.



A week before Father's Day, we collect in support of other fathers, those in retirement who gave years of service as priests in the Archdiocese. I have been grateful for Fr. Ed's continuing ministry and support. With smaller ordination classes (only two were ordained for Chicago a couple weeks ago), we should not take their service for granted. Let us be generous with our support, our thanks, and our prayers.

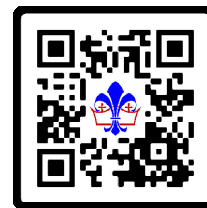
