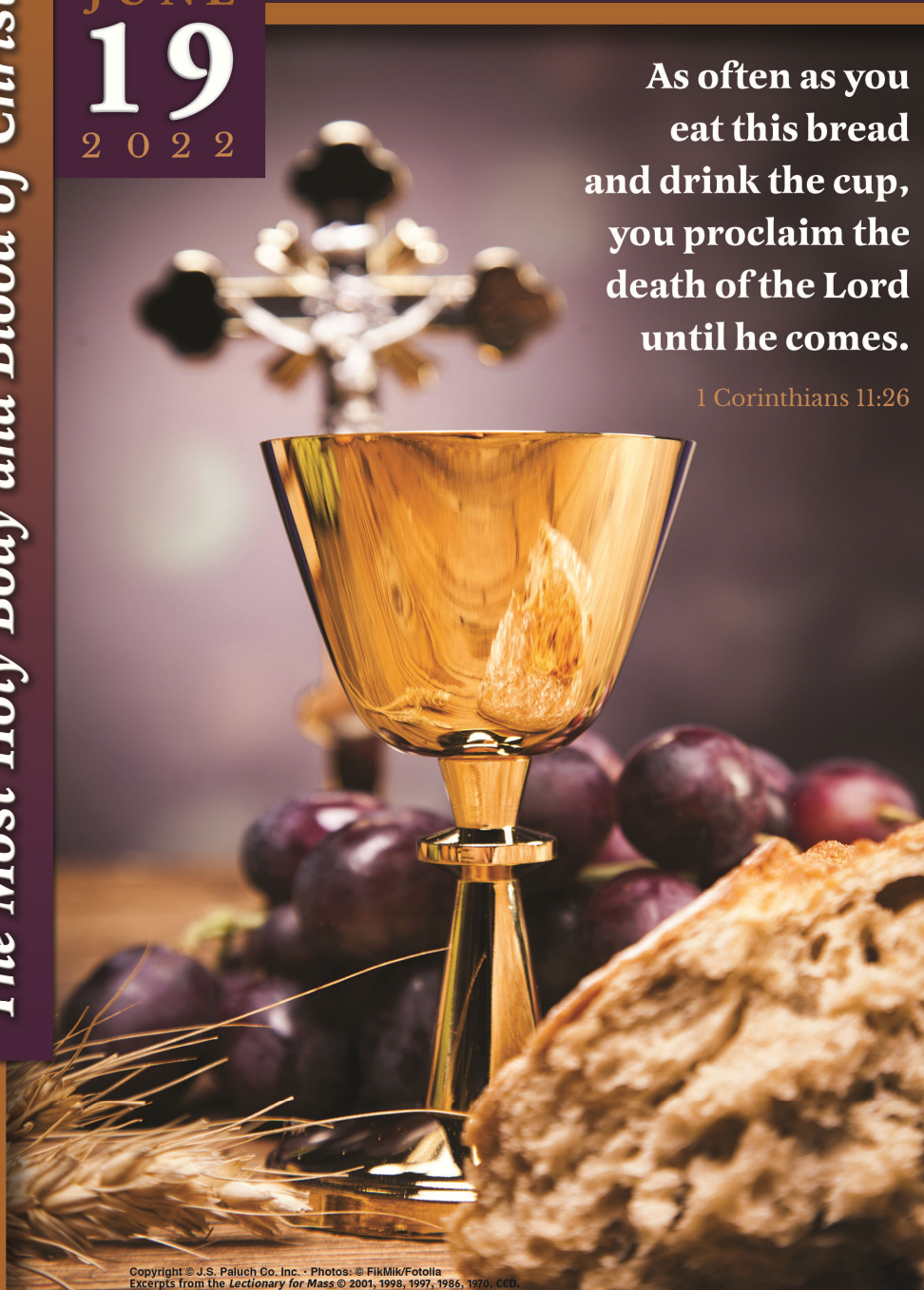

Fr. Marty's Musings

Jesus feeds a crowd after teaching them of the Kingdom of God, yet performs an even greater miracle every day as wheat and wine truly become Christ's real presence in the Eucharist. We honor that in the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ.

The Church restored receiving Communion in the hand in the 1970s. When Covid-19 struck the world, the Church asked us to use that option and refrain from Communion on the tongue for the time. Communion in the hand is an appropriate and respectful way to receive the Eucharist. Although it is still the recommended way because of the pandemic, Communion on the tongue is permitted. We do ask that you wait towards the end of the Communion procession because of the sanitation recommendation.

Communion in the hand preceded the practice of receiving on the tongue. Our tongues are not worthier than our hands and we acknowledge that we are not worthy before Communion, yet Christ still offers his Body and Blood for us. Our tongues probably participate in more sins than our hands. The Church suppressed Communion in the hand at a time when few people received regularly and to assure that the host was consumed. Also, the Church did not use individual round hosts then, but broke unleavened bread into smaller pieces. The issue of crumbs falling would have been a bigger concern than now with individual hosts.

We should receive respectfully and thoughtfully. Make a simple bow of reverence before stepping to the minister. When the minister holds forth the host and proclaims, "The Body of Christ," we respond "Amen," meaning "It is so!" We do not greet our Lord with silence. We state our faith that Christ is present in the Eucharist and commit to be to be part of Christ's Body, the Church.

We do not take the host but allow the minister to place the host in our hands. We present one hand cupped to

receive the host, with the dominant hand underneath. As St. Cyril of Jerusalem instructed:

When you approach, take care not to do so with your hand stretched out and your fingers open or apart, but rather place your left hand as a throne beneath your right, as befits one who is about to receive the King. Then receive him, taking care that nothing is lost.

After receiving the host, the Communicant takes the host in the dominant hand to consume it. You may bite the host, but please chew respectfully.

If you receive on the tongue, respond "Amen" and extend your tongue far enough (but not too far) to receive the host. Keep your tongue still until you receive the host.

The Communion fast is an hour (before Vatican II, it was from midnight). You can drink water at any time. For the hospitalized or homebound, the fast is fifteen minutes. Food and drink (except for babies) do

not belong in the worship space. Gum should be deposited in the trash can.

Please silence cell phones in church. We also show our respect by how we dress. Men traditionally remove hats in church. We bow before the altar and genuflect to the Body of Christ reserved in the tabernacle (except in the Triduum, when the tabernacle is empty).

Let us give thanks in the original root meaning of Eucharist that Christ gives of his very Body and Blood out of love. May we say "Amen" to him in word and actions



Happy Father's Day to all our dads! May the men who modeled for us a sense of God the Father's infinite love know how much we love and owe them.

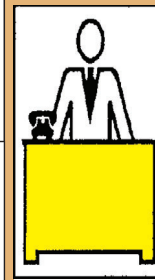
