St. Bernadette Church is dedicated to St. Bernadette Soubirous of Lourdes (January 7, 1844 – April 16, 1879). She is likely the first saint to be photographed. Those who remember Family Classics enjoyed when WGN aired the 1947 movie "The Song of Bernadette." Jennifer Jones won an Oscar for portraying St. Bernadette. The film is based on a book by Franz Werfel, a Jewish writer who told the story in appreciation for the kindness shown to his wife and him in sheltering them from the Nazis.

Fr. Marty Marren served as deacon at St. Bernadette (1983–1984) while Fr. Richard Laske was pastor.

Even though he may not have taken my advice, I know he always listened. And for that, I thank you. I truly feel that we are losing a pastor who gave his heart to Queen of Martyrs. The good thing is he will be "just down the street" from us. I also know he will always have a spot in his heart for all of us. I will miss you, my friend. Follow that Holy Spirit of freedom and love. Just remember, "Once a wildcat, always a wildcat!!"
